Vermont Certified Horticulturists are required to file an **annual** Renewal Application documenting 10 credit hours of continuing education or professional association involvement (1 credit hour = minimum 60 minutes lecture time). The annual renewal fee for recertification is \$35.00. All VCHers who fail to file a renewal application and pay the appropriate fee by **December 31st** will no longer be certified.
